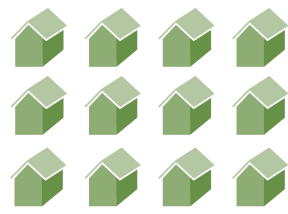

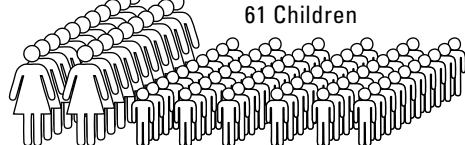

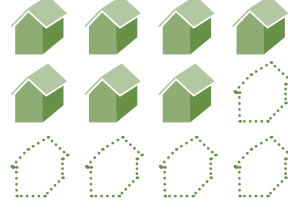

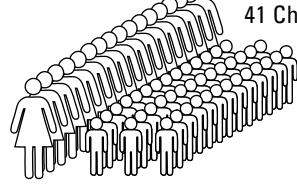

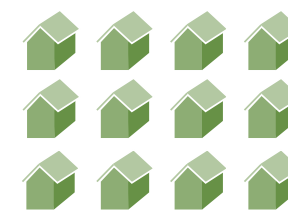

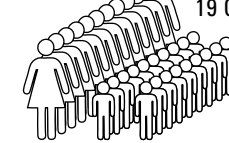

Permanent Supportive Housing Annual Impact

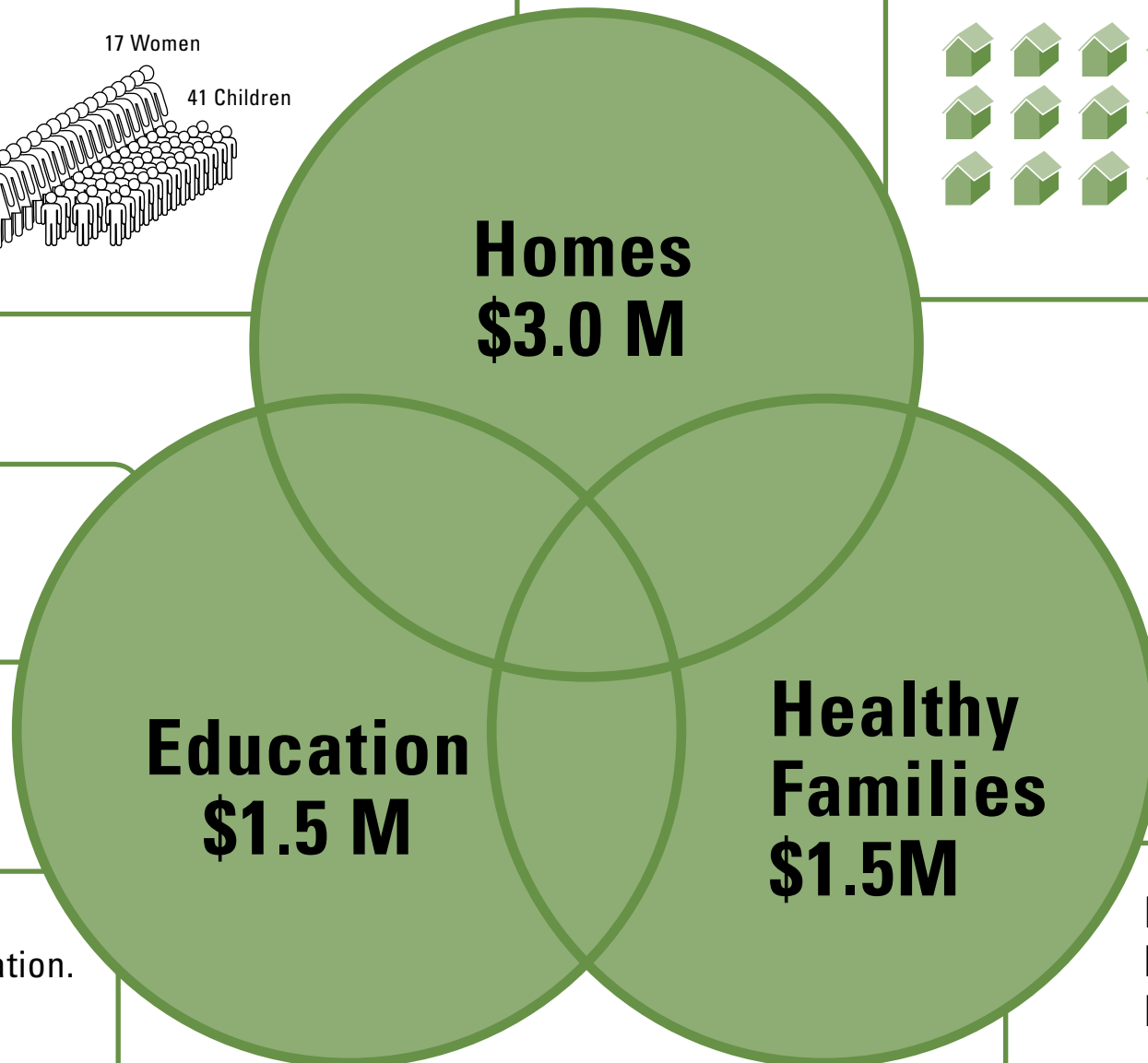

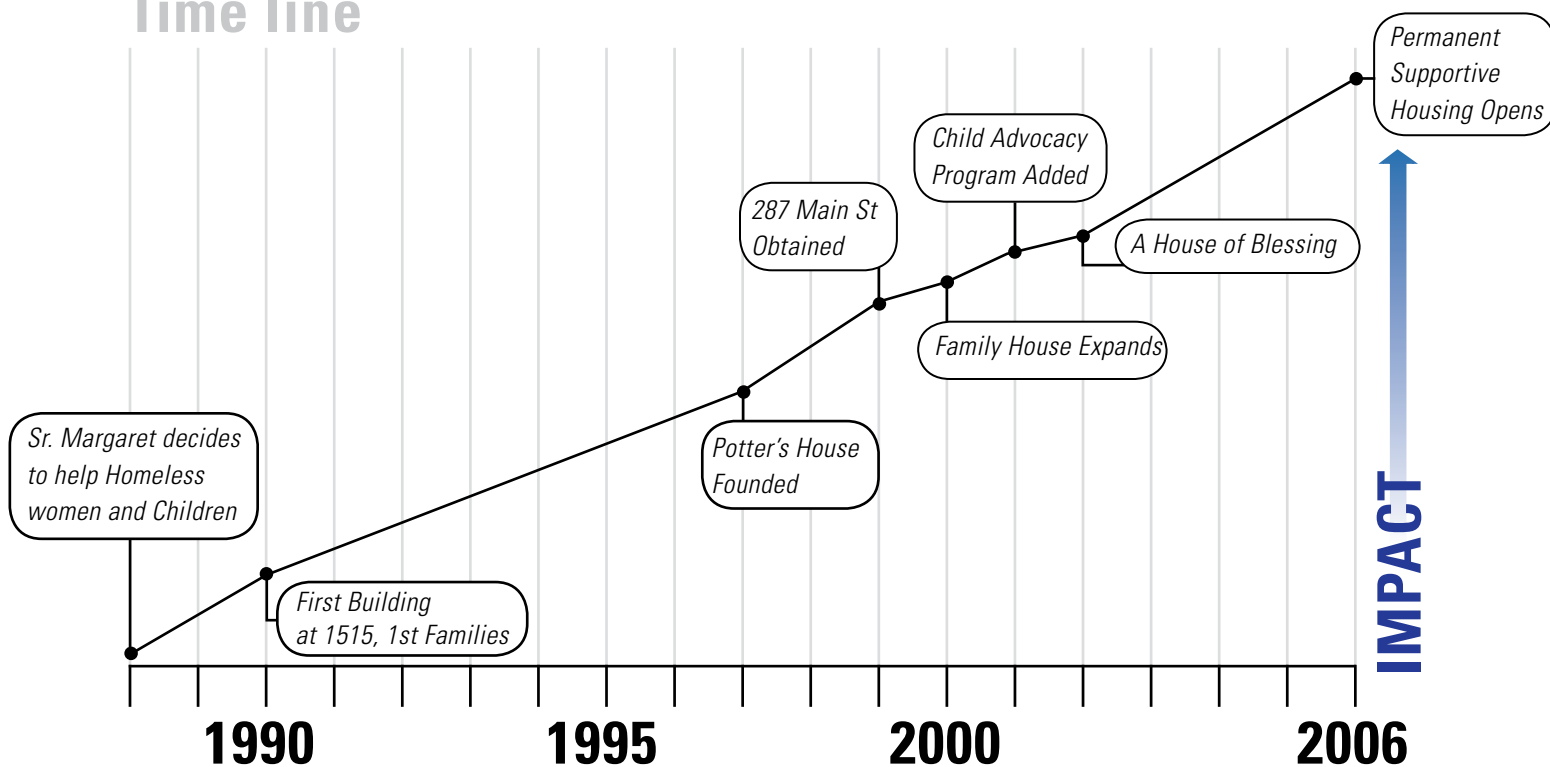

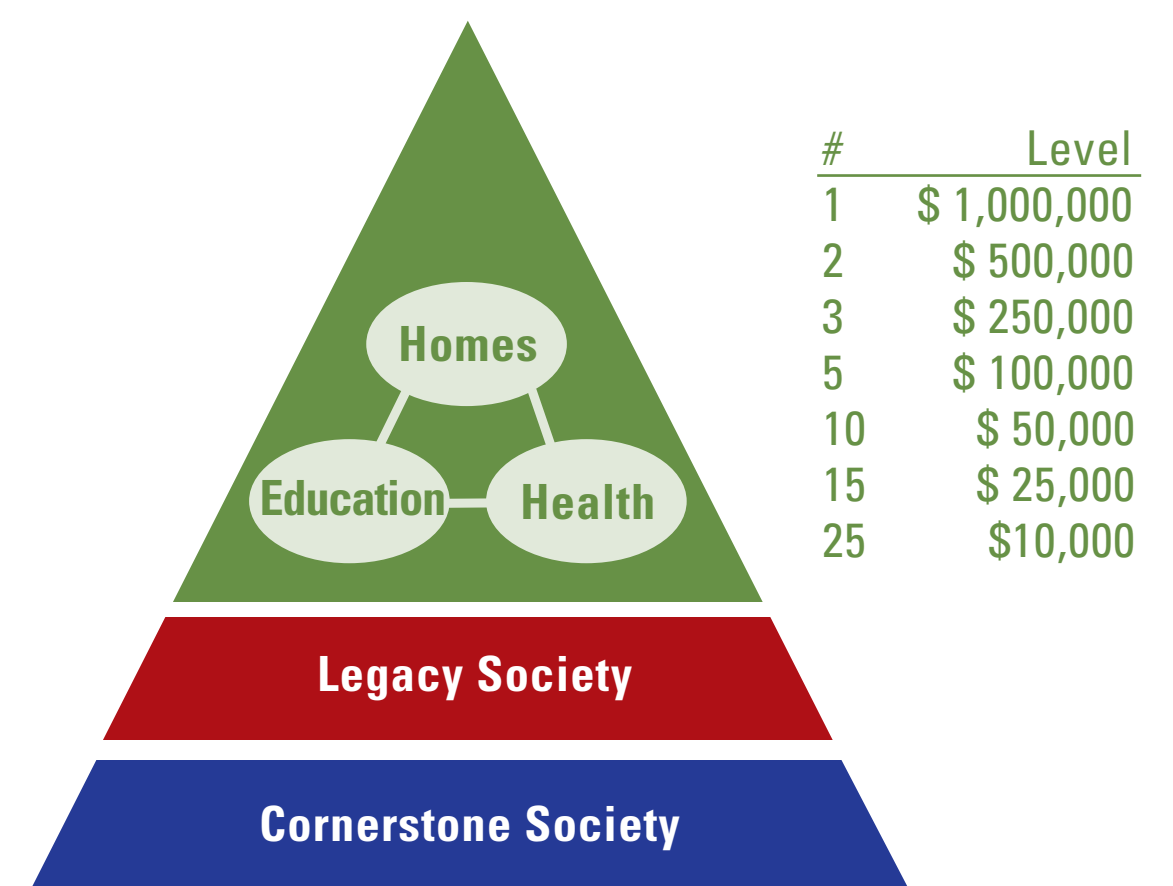
